Danger Signs – Things to call about

- 1) Bleeding from the Vagina
- 2) Cramping or pain in the lower abdomen
- 3) Burning, pain or difficulty with urinating
- 4) Sudden swelling in the feet, hands or face
- 5) Severe Headaches
- 6) Visual Disturbances – blurry vision or seeing of “spots”
- 7) Sudden gush of water from the vagina
- 8) Constant leaking of water (like a dripping faucet) from the vagina
- 9) Contraction before you are due
- 10) Persistent vomiting – “Can’t keep anything down”
- 11) If you stop feeling the baby move or if it moves less than 6 times an hour.
